### ***Trolley to Downtown (Saturday from 10am – 6pm - \$1 per person)***

The Trolley will be going to downtown Winchester and dropping off at the corner of Stewart and Boscawen streets from 10am to 7pm Saturday. It will leave Candy Hill every hour on the hour. Fee for round trip is \$1 per person.

### ***Sunday at 9:45 a.m. in the Pavilion:***

Join the Rev. Kenneth Smith and the Open Door Baptist Church for a come-as-you-are worship service. All are welcome. Metal folding chairs are available in the Pavilion, or bring your own. *Please note that this service is available to campers every Sunday morning at Candy Hill Campground.*

- Please display your car pass at all times. Anyone without a car pass will not be admitted into the park.
- You may have a fire between the hours of 4pm and 11pm. Please request a fire ring from the office. All fires must be out by 11!
- Our store hours are 8am until 9pm Thursday Night and 8am until 10pm Friday & Saturday Night.
